This report is used to scout opponents coaching tendencies, how often they throw certain pitches on certain counts and how likely they are to make a pickoff move. This also is used for pitchers tendencies as well as bunts and stolen bases. These reports are called Coaching Tendencies, and these are extremely useful for the coaches to have a better idea of what is likely to happen on the field.

This is a report that can be used for defensive shifts and infield defense. It gives a good idea of how to play defense on each hitter that is faced, and gives us a general idea of what we should worry about when they get to the plate. This combined with the Pitcher Attack gives a lot of information about the opponents batters.

Overall, all of these reports give a picture of how to attack an opposing team, and is also simple enough for coaches and players to understand the information being presented. These reports can also be used in player development to see how an opponent would attack our team, and allows adjustments to hitter and pitcher approach.
